CHANGES TO SPONSORING PARENTS AND GRANDPARENTS AS CANADIAN PERMANENT RESIDENTS

New for 2017! Immigration, Citizenship and Refugees Canada has announced that for the first time there will be a draw for those wishing to sponsor parents and grandparents for immigration to Canada. There will be 10,000 spots available. Beginning January 3, 2017, those seeking to sponsor a parent or grandparent will have 30 days to submit an online indication of interest. Then, Immigration, Citizenship and Refugees Canada will randomly select 10,000 individual who will be invited to complete a formal application.
